ABOUT LONGWOOD UNIVERSITY

Longwood University, located in the heart of Virginia, is a coeducational, comprehensive public institution offering 100 majors, minors, and concentrations to more than 4,800 students. Founded in 1839, Longwood offers undergraduate programs in business administration, education and human services, the arts and sciences, plus graduate programs in education, English, sociology, and a new M.B.A in retail management.

With a student body from more than 35 states and foreign countries, Longwood offers students the benefits of a small college, allowing professors and students to develop close, personal relationships. Longwood's Academic and Career Advising Center helps students explore majors and career options; links students with internships, job opportunities, and graduate school programs; and offers campus recruiting programs and job/internship fairs. In addition, Longwood is the only public institution in Virginia and one of only a few in the country to require internships or research projects of all students.
