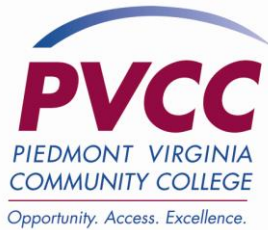

- For the fourth time in the last five years, a PVCC student was among the top 20 community college students in the nation *and* the highest-ranking student in the 23-member Virginia community college system, earning him the designation as the 2008 New Century Scholar for Virginia.
- With a \$95,000 Department of Labor, PVCC is developing a program in green technologies for the construction industry. The program provides training for energy auditors, building analysts and weatherization technicians.
